

## North Graceleigh Park

The developer of Beechmont Rise had to hand-over a block of land (8.869 hectares) to the SRRC for parkland. This land is immediately adjacent to and north of Graceleigh Park. [See map](#). The two lots immediately to the south of the Park are the school on the left and Graceleigh Park on the right. Please note that Mabfield Court is now Jervis Place.

There is a conservation corridor on either side of Back Creek. This was fought for by locals some time ago.

BRASA has been speaking to SRRC officials regarding the possible use of this land; including sporting facilities and camping ground.

This land currently zoned parkland is in the SRRC's land bank and would need to be rezoned to sports and recreation for any sporting facilities. This could take several years.

We have named this North Graceleigh Park for easier referencing.

Possible uses of this park are

- Expansion of sporting facilities including skate-park and netball courts
- Camping Ground
- Toilet and Shower Block
- Botanical/permaculture gardens
- Nature reserve
