

BRASA CONSTITUTION - OBJECTIVES OF BRASA

The objects of the association are—

- To administer the affairs of the Community Recreation, Arts & Sporting Centre. A public utility provided by the Scenic Rim Regional Council in the interests of the community. *Graceleigh Park excluding Hall on Graceleigh which is owned by the QLD State Government. The land on which Hall on Graceleigh sits is owned in trust by Scenic Rim Regional Council and leased to QLD State Government.*
- To be responsible for the overall maintenance and general improvement of the facility, namely the Beechmont Recreation, Arts and Sports Association Incorporated.
- To foster community interest in the centre by encouraging utilisation of the centre to the fullest.
- To establish funds for the general conduct of the organisation.
- To expend funds in accordance with the stated objects of the organisation.
- To at all times be non-secretarian and non-political.
- To work in cooperation with the Beechmont State School to raise funds to maintain and improve the Hall on Graceleigh. *Raise funds, not spend our current moneys. Grants through the Beechmont P and C to improve hall?.*
- To provide the facilities and environment for social contact between members and their friends and generally to afford to them all the usual privileges, benefits and conveniences of a club. *Determined by the members*
- To engage in such other activities whether of a like nature or not, as may for the time being be permitted by law and determined by the Management Committee. *Like nature to what? Assume that it is any recreational, art and sports activities.*

Not limited to users of Graceleigh Park and/or Hall on Graceleigh. Also does not mention any limitations to Beechmont. This should be implied?
